

DIY Fire Starters

Easy DIY fire starter that lights instantly and cost almost nothing but your time.

Materials:

- Lint
- Newspaper
- Toilet paper rolls - cut in half
- Candles
- String
- Herbs - *Sage helps keep bugs away* (not essential but nice if you have it)
- Wax or parchment paper
- Cookie sheet

Directions:

1. Place wax or parchment paper on cookie sheet and place toilet paper rolls out on the tray.
2. Stuff each roll with lint until its pretty full.
3. Light a candle, tilt on the side and drip wax into the roll onto the lint (always taking care not to burn yourself or light the roll or lint on fire).
4. If you have fresh herbs, place on top of the lint in the roll.
5. Roll a sheet of newspaper around the toilet paper roll and tie off with string so that they look like Christmas crackers.
