

# Cozy Pillow Bed Sewing Tutorial

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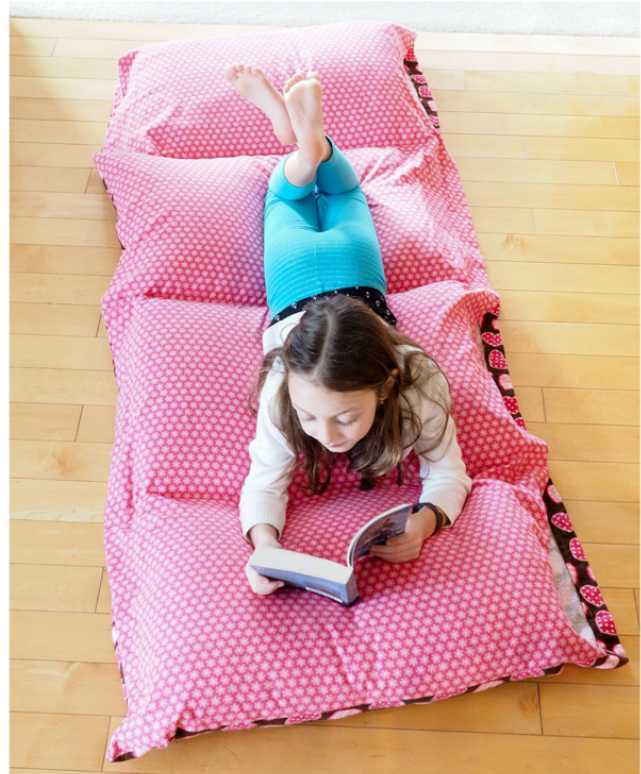
Finished size: 33 x 74 inches (83.8 x 185.4 cm) | Seam Allowance: 1/2" (1.3 cm)

## Supplies:

- 2.25 yards (2 m) flannel material in pattern 1 (you can also just choose to do the entire bed in one pattern if you prefer)
- 2.25 yards (2 m) flannel material in pattern 2
- Sewing machine and thread
- Sharp scissors or rotary cutter
- Pins
- Measuring tape
- Pencil or water soluble marker
- 4 pillows

## Directions:

1. Using your scissors or rotary cutting tool, cut both pieces of flannel material to measure 34.5" x 75". (PHOTO A)
2. With both flannel pieces facing their right sides together, pin around one short side, one long side, and the other short side (one long side will not be pinned together). (PHOTO B)



3. Machine sew the three pinned sides together, leaving a 1/2" seam as you sew. Remove pins as you sew. (PHOTO C)
4. Trim the points off the stitched corners with scissors. (PHOTO D)
5. On the one long raw side that hasn't been sewn, fold over and pin the material twice so that there's approximately a 1/2" seam. (PHOTO E)
6. Machine sew the 1/2" seam along the edge of the material (do not sew the two sides together) and turn right side out. (PHOTO F)
7. Starting at one short end, mark a line across every 18.5 inches down until you reach the other short end. This will divide you pillow bed into four equal sections. Stitch along each line to make four pillow pockets. (PHOTO G)
8. Stuff each of the four pockets with a pillow. (PHOTO H)
